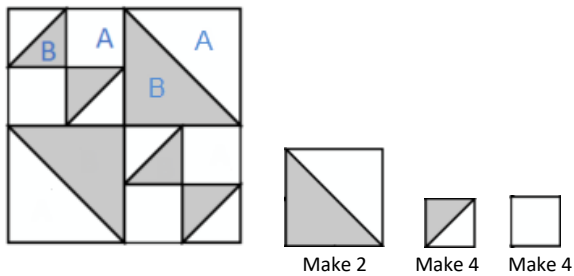


Sympathy Block – Crosses and Losses

Finished Size: 9 inches Unfinished size: 9½ inches



For One Block:

Cut:

Off white (Fabric A)

1 – 5 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 5 $\frac{3}{8}$ " square. Cut in half diagonally – once.

2 – 3 $\frac{1}{8}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{8}$ " squares. Cut in half diagonally – once.

4 – 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " squares.

Print (Fabric B)

1 – 5 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 5 $\frac{3}{8}$ " square. Cut in half diagonally – once.

2 – 3 $\frac{1}{8}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{8}$ " squares. Cut in half diagonally – once.

Stitch:

1. Sew Fabric A triangles to Fabric B triangles along the diagonal. Press towards the print.
2. Sew small half square triangle (HST) to small square. Do this 4 times.
3. Sew 2 – 4 patches using units from step 2.
4. Sew a 4 patch to each large half square triangle. Press towards the large HST.
5. Sew the units from step 4 together.
6. Sign the block in any Fabric A area, away from the raw edges.
